Conditions of Play Club Championship

- 1. All Championship events will be played in accordance with the Laws of Bowls** (Crystal Mark Edition 4.0 or higher), and the Bowls Australia Domestic Regulations. All players need to be aware of these rules before Play.
- 2. Eligibility**
 - 2.1** To be eligible for Club Championship events, a player must be a fully financial member of this Club.
 - 2.2** *For the in-house Club events e.g., Pairs/Triples and the Minor Singles, a social member is eligible to take part, but must play with at least 1 fully financial member for team events.*
- 3. Controlling Body**
 - 3.1** The Championship Committee (the Controlling Body) reserves the right to amend the Conditions of Play as necessary.
 - 3.2** Any appeals or disputes must be raised directly with Championship Committee. For 2023/2024 the contact point is Rodney Bates.
 - 3.3** The Board of Management will determine the structure of the Championship Committee on an annual basis.
- 4. Club Championships** are organized around the Bowls Victoria and Eastern Ranges events
- 5. Entries**
 - 5.1** Entries are accepted on completion of entry forms and payment for that event.
 - 5.2** Entries will not be accepted after the nominated closing date as per the published schedule.
 - 5.3** Entry Forms will be available (at YGBC interior Bar) approximately 1 month before the closing date.
 - 5.4** The Draw will be published on our website and on the Clubrooms noticeboard.
- 6. Schedule of Matches - completion date.**
 - 6.1** All matches must be played on or before the scheduled date.
 - 6.2** All games not completed on or before the scheduled date will be automatically forfeited.
 - 6.3** Games where a walkover is given must be notified to the championship Committee on or before the scheduled date.

7. **Singles Matches** - the markers for the first game in Singles are to be arranged by the players named in the match. It is a condition of entry that losing players will always make themselves or a replacement available to act as a Marker in subsequent games.
8. **No play, practice, or training is permitted** on any club green on the day on which the club match has been scheduled.
9. **Trial ends** – one trial end in each direction can be played prior to the commencement of each game. By mutual agreement, players may play fewer trial ends.
10. **Dead Ends** are replayed.

Club Championship Events for 2022-2023

Club Singles Championship:

- Men's and Women's titles;
- 4 bowls per player;
- All games are the first to 25 shots

Minor Championship

- Competition for players who have not won a minor or major club event;
- It encourages new bowlers to participate;
- 4 bowls per player;
- All games are the first to 21 shots

Pairs Championship:

- Men's and Women's and mixed titles
- 3 bowls per player;
- All games are of 15 ends duration;
- In the event of a tie, an extra end will be played to determine the winner.

Triples Club Championship:

- Mixed event title;
- 2 bowls per player
- All games are of 15 ends duration;
- In the event of a tie, an extra end will be played to determine the winner.
